Boise Pony Club Schooling Show Rules and Regulations

Classes designated **Junior** are for riders 17 or younger (age as of January 1, 2023). *No professionals. **Open Classes** are for all riders.

*USEF - "A professional is any rider who accepts remuneration for service—compensation or payment in any form, such as cash, goods, sponsorships, discounts or services, reimbursement of any expenses; trade or in-kind exchange of goods or services such as board or training."

Two rounds per class allowed, first will be designated as a schooling round, second round will be judged, no exceptions.

Faults – Knockdowns and refusals are 4 faults. Third disobedience results in elimination. Unsafe riding, excessive speed, or any action against a horse deemed excessive will result in elimination.

Optimum Time Classes – The rider with least amount of faults that comes closest to the time allowed (over or under) will be the winner. Time Allowed is determined by judge's measurement of the course and appropriate speed:

- Ground Poles 200 meters per minute (medium trot)
- 18" 2' Jumper 275 meters per minute (fast trot/slow canter)
- 2'3" and up 350 meters per minute (medium canter)

Gambler's Choice – Rider will choose own course. Each jump is assigned a point value based on its difficulty. Rider will try to accumulate the most points as possible, SAFELY, within 60 seconds. A whistle will be blown at the end of time. Rider with the most points accumulated is the winner. <u>A special course map with point</u> values and more instructions will be provided at registration.

Mid-day Merriment are fun classes, \$2 each, during a short break between the 3'6" and Ground Poles classes, time allowing. The two options will be announced at the start of the show.

Leadline – One at a time, over ground pole course. Walk or trot only. Coaching is allowed. \$2, not judged.

No refunds on no-shows. Refund minus \$10 Admin Fee with a doctor or vet note if within 48 hours of start.

PLEASE NOTE!

- 1.) All riders need to have a signed Pony Club release form as well as Once Upon A Horse release form.
- 2.) You must fill out form to add classes or rounds the day of show, at \$20 each.
- 3.) Classes will not be held for any riders.
- 4.) Well-fitting, ASTM/SEI approved equestrian helmets and hard-soled boots required for all riders. Schooling attire recommended.
- 5.) Porta Potty will be available. Please do not enter the barn at OUAH if you are not a boarder.
- 6.) No dogs allowed on premises.
- 7.) Snacks will be available to purchase.
